

For New and Returning Coaches- Just some important Reminders:

New Coaches- If you do not yet have your F license, you must do so. Please go to www.njyouthsoccer.com and look for locations for the course. It takes place on a Friday night/Saturday morning. The Club will reimburse the cost.

Uniforms – Each team should have a person identified to be the point of contact relative to uniforms. That person will work with the coach of the team and K. Villani for uniform merchandise. The Club website has a page for “Uniform” that outlines the merchandise.

Tournament

Parent Volunteers

Each team will be required to name a Tournament Rep, Ad Rep and Field Rep for the tournament. It is best to do so at the Parents Meeting since that will be the last contact with most of them before practices and the tournament at the end of the summer.

Tournament Advertising Book

Each team is responsible for purchasing ads for the tournament book. Most parents will purchase a ¼ or ½ page ad wishing their child good luck in the tournament. You don't want your player looking through the whole book and not finding their ad.

Corporate Sponsors

Corporate sponsors are needed and get special recognition in the book, at the tournament and on the club's website for the year. This is a great source of donations for the club and is typically a successful way for community involvement from local companies.

More info on all the above and a run down of the tournament schedule will be given at the coaches meeting. The first tournament meeting will be next week at the New Albany Rec Center, more info to follow. It is highly recommended that new coaches attend this first meeting along with their Tournament and Ad reps.

KidsSafe Forms

Every coach will be required to fill out a Kidsafe form which will be kept by the Coaching coordinator. In addition, permission may be asked from performance of criminal background searches of all coaches.

Parents Meeting:

Prior to the end of the school year, you must conduct a parent's meeting- normally at your home to introduce yourself to the team and any new members. For those of you new to the Club, this is an opportunity for you to meet all the parents from your team, collect all the

information needed to fill out player passes and discuss items that are of import to your team. Items to request the parents to bring are:

- a. Registration Fee - \$110.00 per player payable to “Moorestown Soccer Club”- this is for the fall season only
- b. Copy of Birth Certificate
- c. Completed Club Membership Form- your child must sign as well- can be found under “forms” on the MSC website
- d. Medical Release form (notarized) – Commerce Bank does it free- can be found under “forms” on the MSC website
- e. A 1x1 picture of player – No hats on head shots.

If you do not have volunteers already, you will need to ask for parent volunteers for the following areas:

- a. Team Uniform Representative - check web site on New Uniform Info.
- b. Team Labor Day Tournament Ad Representative
- c. Team Labor Day Tournament Rep – For the event
- d. Field Representative – Will assist Club members with maintenance of fields upon request.
- e. Publicity Representative – Submit game articles to Club POC on Sunday evenings.
